II. STATE LEGISLATION

A. Legislative Update – Informational Item – Full Moon Strategies

Jael Dantas, Full Moon Strategies, provided updates on the Legislature's schedule through mid-May 2026 and on ballot initiatives and measures in the 2026 pipeline.. He noted a few important dates for the ballot measure qualification timeline and the Legislature's schedule.

Key Ballot Measure Qualification Timeline:

- March 23, 2026 – Last day for the Secretary of State to determine whether the measure qualifies for the ballot or if a full signature check is required.
- June 18, 2026 – If a 100% signature verification is required, this is the deadline for county elections officials to certify results to the Secretary of State.

- June 25, 2026 – Last day for the Secretary of State to determine that the measure is eligible and qualified for the ballot.
- November 3, 2026 – General Election Day

Key Legislature Schedule Dates

- April 6, 2026: The Legislature convenes from Spring Recess.
- April 6, 2026: The Senate Budget Subcommittee #3 on Health and Human Services and the Assembly Budget Subcommittee #1 on Health hearings
 - Hearing on Gender Affirming Care and Part 3 will be about California's Response to H.R. 1.
- April 8, 2026: Select Committee on CalFresh hearing
- April 8, 2026: Joint Budget Subcommittee on Human Services & Education hearing
- April 9, 2026: Senate Budget Subcommittee No. 3 on Health & Human Services hearing
- April 24, 2026: Last day for policy committees to hear and report to fiscal committees fiscal bills introduced in their house.
- May 1, 2026: Last day for policy committees to hear and report to the Floor non-fiscal bills introduced in their house.
- May 8, 2026: Last day for policy committees to meet prior to June 1.
