ACTION SUMMARY MINUTES

The Personnel/Administration/Legislation Committee meeting convened at 1:31 p.m. with Supervisor Tam presiding as Chair.

I. FEDERAL LEGISLATION

A. Legislative Update – Informational Item – CJ Lake

Emily Bacque Da Silva and John Assini, CJ Lake, provided an update on the Senate’s budget resolution regarding immigration enforcement funding, as well as the House’s progress in passing a three-year Foreign Intelligence Services Act Section 702 reauthorization bill and the Farm bill. They also reported that Grand Old Party members in both houses continue to delay any formal action on Congress’ war-making authority.

The committee received the federal legislative update and did not take any action. The item was informational only and no action was required.

II. STATE LEGISLATION

A. Legislative Update – Informational Item – Full Moon Strategies

Amy Costa, Full Moon Strategies, provided a general overview of the Legislature’s activities during the week of April 20-25, 2026. She also provided updates on the status of Senate Bill 1193 (Wahab) and on the state budget.
