Brendon Woods, Public Defender, Alameda County Public Defender's Office, presented a PowerPoint presentation on the Community Advisory Board (CAB) Guidelines.

On January 8, 2013, the Board of Supervisors directed the Community Corrections Partnership Executive (CCPE EC) Committee to bring a proposal to the Public Protection Committee to establish a Community Advisory Board.

The purpose of the CAB is to advise and make recommendations to the Community Corrections Partnership Executive Committee on the County's on-going realignment and re-entry planning strategies. The proposed CAB membership is fifteen members; three (3) from each supervisorial district and at least 1 of the 3 members must be formerly incarcerated. The Board of Supervisors is the final decision making authority for budget allocations relating to realignment and re-entry.

After a series of meetings with the CCP EC and the community the proposed CAB guidelines were established. The CCP EC approved the guidelines at their December 16, 2013 meeting.

The CCPEC requests the Public Protection Committee approve the proposed CAB guidelines and move to the full Board of Supervisors for adoption.
