Sergeant Priscilla Silva, Programs Director, Re-Entry and Support Services Unit, Alameda County Sheriff's Office, provided a PowerPoint presentation on the Santa Rita Jail Women's Programming and Programming Pod.

In January 2025, the Alameda County Sheriff's Office Re-Entry & Support Services Unit (RESS) conducted a survey with the women's population to better understand their specific needs and improve rehabilitation and re-entry services. The Re-Entry and Support Services Unit partnered with: Five Keys School, Chabot College, Las Positas College, Aramark Food Company and the Alameda County Sheriff's Office Regional Training Center to coordinate class and program offerings such as hair braiding, food certification CPR/First Aid and music production.

Ursula Jones Dickson, District Attorney, Alameda County District Attorney's Office, provided a PowerPoint presentation on the 2025 Annual Review of the Alameda County District Attorney's Office.

DA Jones Dickson provided an overview of the District Attorney's Office mission, legal mandates, and victim rights (Marcy's Law). She stated that there has been an increase in case processing and referrals with a focus on prosecutorial capacity. The DA's Office has expanded victim services at the Family Justice Center. The DA's office has also focused on gun violence prevention and retail theft enforcement.
