Estelle Clemons, Executive Director, Alameda County-Oakland Community Action Partnership, presented a PowerPoint presentation on the Alameda County-Oakland Community Action Partnership.

The Alameda County-Oakland Community Action Partnership (AC-OCAP) is committed to reducing poverty by providing services and programs targeted to low-income individuals and families. AC-OCAP has been funding programs and projects in the low-income community since 1971. Their mission is to improve the community by creating pathways that lead to economic opportunity and prosperity. The Vision Statement is to “*To end poverty within the City of Oakland and throughout Alameda County*”.

The Community Action Partnership has the responsibility to plan, develop, and execute efforts to alleviate poverty and work toward systemic change to enhance the opportunities for families of low-income throughout Alameda County to achieve self-sufficiency.

AC OCAP 2017 Outcomes

70,311 – Low income Alameda County residents served by AC OCAP
1,906 – Residents received legal assistance
19,000 – Oakland low income children served summer lunches
20,562 – Residents received free tax preparation
619 - Families housed
128 - Residents employed
\$23.5 million in tax refunds received by low wage earners
\$678,854 in Community Service Block Grant (CSBG) funds invested into the community
