Injury and Illness Prevention Program (IIPP) Components

(1) Identify the person or persons with <u>authority and</u> <u>responsibility</u> for implementing the Program

(2) Include a system for <u>ensuring that employees</u> <u>comply</u> with safe and healthy work practices.

Injury and Illness Prevention Program (IIPP) Components

(3) Include a system for <u>communicating with</u> <u>employees</u> in a form readily understandable

(4) Include procedures for <u>identifying and evaluating</u> work place hazards including scheduled periodic inspections

Injury and Illness Prevention Program (IIPP) Components

(5) Include a procedure to <u>investigate occupational</u> <u>injuries</u>

(6) Include methods and/or procedures for <u>correcting</u> <u>unsafe or unhealthy conditions</u> in a timely manner

(7) Provide training and instruction
