
Castro Valley Boulevard.

- Request for Interest/Development Concepts released on March 1st
- Six responsive proposals received on March 24th
- Selection Committee will interview six development teams on May 10 and 12
- Selection Committee will recommend "preferred developer" during future MAC Meeting
- Six submittals will be available for public review following interviews and before MAC meeting.

- RFI/Dev. Concept issued on Wednesday, March 1
- Six Responses were received Friday, March 24th by 5 PM
- Staff and Consultant Evaluations of Proposals-April
- Interviews with Selection Committee Week of May 10 and 12
- Follow-up interviews (if needed) Tentative, week if May 15-19
- Selection Committee: ECD, Planning, SPA, MAC Members
- Selection Committee's recommended "preferred developer" will be presented at MAC meeting for staff presentation, public discussion and final recommendation.

## **Key Projects for 2017**

#### **Billboards Reduction Program**

- Outfront Media has submitted two billboard applications to the Planning Department and will be presented to the Planning Commission after the CEQA review is completed.
- The proposed locations are Langton Way (off Lewelling and Mission Blvd.)
   and at Arbor and A Street at 88o.
- If approved, 16 billboard faces will be removed and generate revenue to the County.
- Clear Channel will be submitting their two billboards soon.






