
EAST 14TH STREET CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS






Revised Design due to Underground Utility Conflicts.

- retain the existing streamline poles and wires along the median islands.
- Limit undergrounding to existing poles and wires along sidewalks at the north and south ends of the project.
- Follow Streetscape Master Plan Concepts where possible.

Construction Updates:


- Construction on schedule

 - interior colors finalized




