#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Authorize the Purchasing Agent, or her designee, to execute a contract (Master Contract No. 902376; Procurement Contract No. 26466) with Engine Systems Integration, LLC (Principal: Neil Holmgren; Location: Alameda) to provide flood control pump station engineering support services to the Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District for the term of 8/1/24 - 7/31/27, in the amount of \$100,000.

### **DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:**

The Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) maintains and operates four Enterprise DSG318 pump engines at its Ettie Street Flood Control Pump Station, located at 3455 Ettie Street Oakland. These engines have been in service since 1954 and require specialized maintenance and preservation services. The Contractor has technical expertise and will support the ongoing maintenance, preservation, operation, and reliability of the Enterprise DSG318 engines.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA/PROCESS:**

The District has determined that Alameda County does not currently have the resources to provide flood control pump station engineering support services.

The District worked with General Services Agency–Procurement to develop an Informal Request for Proposal (IRFP), which was issued on November 1, 2023, posted on the County and GSA LinkedIn websites for 27 days, sent to the E-Gov Professional Services – Current Contract Opportunities mailing service, and

emailed to the Chambers of Commerce e-mail group. The IRFP was also advertised in The Inter-City Express on November 3, 2023 and the Oakland Post on November 8, 2023. A vendor outreach was conducted on November 8, 2023.

On November 28, 2023, one bidder submitted a response to the IRFP. The bid response was evaluated by the County Evaluator Panel. A maximum total of 525 evaluation points was available for this IRFP. The total evaluation points include 25 preference points derived from a 5% preference for certified Small Local Emerging Business (SLEB) vendors.

Engine Systems Integration, LLC was the sole bidder who submitted the response, met all requirements, received favorable references, and is being recommended for award.

Engine Systems Integration, LLC is a certified SLEB (Certified Small: 19-00087; Expiration: 10/31/2024).
