SUBJECT: AWARD A CONTRACT TO LINEV SYSTEMS US, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE OF A FULL-BODY FORENSIC X-RAY MACHINE AND SERVICES; MASTER CONTRACT NO. 902637; PROCUREMENT CONTRACT NO. 29227; AMOUNT: \$608,220

Dear Board Members:

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- A. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, or her designee, to execute a contract (Master Contract No. 902637; Procurement Contract No. 29227) with LINEV Systems US, Inc. (Principal: Lukas Richter; Location: Conroe, Texas) for the purchase of a full-body forensic X-ray machine and services to the Alameda County Sheriff's Office, for the term of 10/1/25 – 9/30/27, in the amount of \$608,220; and
- B. Authorize the Auditor-Controller to make the technical budgetary adjustments.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:

The Alameda County Sheriff's Office (ACSO) - Coroner's Bureau requires advanced radiographic imaging capabilities to support forensic casework, particularly for the analysis of deceased individuals. The purchase of a stationary, full-body digital X-ray system is essential for the internal visualization and documentation of injuries, foreign objects, and pathological findings. The system must be suitable for a high-volume forensic environment and comply with all applicable federal, state, and local regulations governing radiation-emitting devices.

Contractor will provide a complete solution that includes: a stationary digital radiology X-ray system capable of full-body imaging; delivery and installation at the designated facility; system calibration and performance verification; on-site staff training; and comprehensive documentation, including user manuals, training guides, and maintenance instructions, as well as warranty support.

SELECTION CRITERIA/PROCESS:

ACSO – Coroner's Bureau has determined that the County of Alameda does not currently have the resources to provide a full-body forensic X-ray machine and services.

ACSO – Coroner's Bureau worked with General Services Agency (GSA)–Procurement to develop a Request for Quotation (RFQ), which was issued on June 12, 2025, posted on the County and GSA LinkedIn websites for 39 days, emailed to the Chambers of Commerce e-mail group, and sent to the E-Gov Goods and Services

– *Current Contract Opportunities mailing service. The RFQ was also advertised in the Inter-City Express on June 16, 2025, and the San Francisco Daily Journal on June 17, 2025. A vendor outreach was conducted on June 18, 2025, followed by one networking/bidders conference on June 23, 2025, which was attended by two attendees representing one vendor.*

On July 21, 2025, one bidder submitted a response to the RFQ. The response was evaluated by GSA and ACSO – Coroner’s Bureau based on the lowest pricing and the County’s requirement for the full-body forensic X-ray machine.

LINEV Systems US, Inc., was the sole bidder who submitted the response, met all requirements, received favorable references, and is being recommended for award.

The Small Local Emerging Business (SLEB) program requirement was applied to this RFQ; however, there were no subcontracting opportunities due to the specialized nature of the requested goods and services. The Office of Acquisition Policy has issued SLEB Waiver No. 10410 (Expiring: 9/30/2027).
