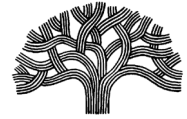

This operational permit for **Removal of Underground Storage Tanks** is here by granted and is effective 02/27/2025 and expires on 08/27/2025.

The holder of this permit agrees to maintain the building/business compliant with City, State, and Federal standards associated with the business operations. Failure to do so will result in the termination of this fire permit. At the time this permit was issued, the facility was in compliance with the City of Oakland Fire Code. The permit holder understands this permit must be renewed prior to the expiry date indicated above. Below is a list of specific permit conditions:

1. Provide certification for the following licenses: HazMat, Evacuation, and Removal tank.
2. The work plan and health and safety plan must include the following:
 - The removal site must be secured with a barricade. A "NO SMOKING" sign must be attached to the barricade if flammable liquids (e.g., gasoline) are being removed.
 - The tank must be inerted and purged before removal:
 - Inerting consist of removing all product and triple-rinsing tank.
 - Purging consists of adding dry ice to remove vapors. Purging is required mainly for tanks which contained flammable liquids.
 - The LEL (Lower Explosive Limit) must be <10%, and the O2 level must be < 20.9% before removal. These readings must be witnessed by an OFD inspector.
 - The removed product and rinse water must be disposed of as hazardous waste.
 - A 2A40BC fire extinguisher must be present on site.
 - All workers must wear level D PPE
 - Tanks may be disposed of as non-hazardous waste only if certified as clean.
