Subject: Approval and authority for Awards resulting from the FY 2010-2011 Child Abuse

Services Prevention, Intervention & Treatment (CAPIT) RFP.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that your Board:

• Approve the results of the FY 2010-2011 Child Abuse Services Prevention, Intervention & Treatment (CAPIT) Request for Proposal (RFP) process as detailed on Attachment A and related awards, totaling \$1,050,000, as funding augmentations to 15 separate current CBO Master Contractors for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 as detailed on Attachment B for provision of CAPIT services, and delegate authority to the Social Services Agency Director, or designee, to sign and execute the agreements under the Master contracting process.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

This letter requests action by your Board to approve the results of the FY 2010–2011 CAPIT RFP process (Attachment A) and authorize related awards (Attachment B) totaling \$1,050,000 for FY 2010-2011. Resources for the RFP originate from the Child Abuse Prevention Trust Fund, administered by the Child Abuse Prevention Task Force in accordance with AB1733 and AB2994. The Child Abuse Prevention Task Force has been designated by your Board to establish funding priorities and issue the RFP to procure services to meet those priorities. The Alameda County Child Abuse Prevention Task Force, through public meetings with community and agency representatives held on December 3, 2009, has identified a range of services to address child abuse prevention and treatment for residents of Alameda County.

CAPIT services to be funded for FY 2010-2011 will provide a continuum of service delivery to highrisk children and their families throughout Alameda County. Services include parenting education, services to foster children aging out of the system, pregnant/parenting teen mothers, case management, referral and information, crisis intervention, services to homeless children, family therapy, in-home support and other valuable services deemed critical to Alameda County's high-risk population.

SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS:

Statute requires that these funds be awarded through a competitive process. The FY 2010-2011 CAPIT RFP was made available to the public on February 19, 2010 via dissemination to all SSA contractors, community stakeholders, via GSA and other communication. Two separate bidders' conferences were held on March 10, 2010 & March 11, 2010.

A total of 21 proposals requesting a total of \$1,435,938 were accepted. All 21 proposals were then reviewed, evaluated and rated, as per RFP specifications, by a panel consisting of 5 members of the Child Abuse Prevention Taskforce. The panel concluded with proposals rated from a high of 108.8 to a low of 79.0. (See Attachment A). The panel recommended funding the 15 proposals (See Attachment B) scoring above 95.0, each at a \$70,000 award level. These recommendations were based on the geographic, service spread, and service coverage that was inclusive of diverse cultural, ethnic, and language capacities needed throughout the County. SSA received one request for appeal from Davis Street Family Resource Center. The Appeals hearing resulted in a denial. SSA recommends your Board approve and authorize awards to those vendors in amounts as detailed in Attachments A and B.

FINANCING:

Funding for the recommended FY 2010-2011 CAPIT contracts is included in the planned FY 2010-2011 Agency Budget. There are no net County costs.
