Title: Agenda Item Request to Allow all CAB Members Stipend Eligibility

Subject Description/Background: The CAB recommends a change in policy regarding who may be eligible for the CAB participation stipends. The CAB has voted to allow all members of the CAB, to be eligible for the (Formerly Incarcerated/Lived Experience) required stipends, so that it no longer excludes our county's Victims, Veterans, Seniors and Disabled Persons from accessing resources or privileges afforded to others on our board. The change in policy is to effectively recognize all members of the CAB for their sacrifice and services allowing all 15 members effective eligibility for the recourse without placing a hierarchical value on lived experiences.

On May 8<sup>th</sup> 2018, the honorable board of supervisors approved the allocation of funds to provide stipends to formerly incarcerated CAB members. Funding was paid from the community-based organization portion of the AB-109 realignment funding. The stipends were continued to assist in minimizing barriers experienced by formerly incarcerated members.

Fiscal Impact: Funding for all recommendations will come from the AB 109 Public Safety Realignment Allocation FY2021-2022 as recommended by the Community Corrections Partnership Community Advisory Board (CAB). The fiscal impact is to be determined.

Recommendation: The CAB respectfully request that the CCPEC approves the above CAB recommendation and forward it to our county's Honorable Board of Supervisors for discussion and action.
