This is the first of two events exploring this network with the end goal of building a system that provides insights and data between all three parties. The two events will explore: - Event 1: Building tooling for providers -> We will focus on understanding the pain points providers have in delivering their services and coordinating comprehensive care to clients. Our head of product will facilitate the workshop and we invite CBOs and Alameda County to discuss how to create a more connected ecosystem across providers. - Event 2: Al for navigating reentry -> Introducing our Reentry Navigator to both CBOs and clients and individuals; AI digital literacy training; and inviting feedback and co-designing of the tool.
