Goal of the RHP

Assist participants to locate, obtain, and retain stable housing as quickly as possible, while also assisting them in linking to other services needed for successful re-entry and long-term housing stability.





Description of the Program

- The Realignment Housing Program provides rapid rehousing and emergency shelter to individuals who are on supervised probation and are unhoused and at risk of homelessness. Rapid rehousing provides short term rental subsidies and other housing supports.
