Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Priorities

- Deploy Community Coalition model to support equitable access to COVID-19 testing, vaccination and prevention, and to support resilience in under-resourced and disproportionately affected communities
- Release \$12M Request for Proposal (RFP) to partner w/ CBO's to collect data on vaccination rates by census track & evaluate vaccination rates through a race equity lens
- Prepare for implementation of CalAIM initiatives intended to serve the Re-entry population
- Continue in-custody COVID-19 prevention and mitigation efforts, and facilitate vaccine outreach and delivery in Santa Rita Jail
