2. ADA Digital Accessibility Requirement

- Public meetings will include live captions through Microsoft Teams to comply with updated ADA requirements. Instructions were distributed regarding proper use of the microphones during in-person meetings.

3. Brown Act Updates

- An updated copy of the Brown Act was emailed to this body which fulfills one of the new requirements.
- Remote participation consists of the following:
 - Member with a Disability: If a subcommittee member is disabled, they shall be treated as in-person attendance, and their participation counts towards quorum. There is no annual cap on the number of times a member may participate remotely under this provision. The body does not need to vote to approve the remote appearance.
 - Just-Cause Rule (previously treated as “Emergency Circumstances”): Members participating under the just-cause rule may fully participate in the meeting. However, their participation does not count towards quorum. Just cause can mean: Childcare or caregiving need; contagious illness; physical or mental condition that is not subject to a disability as defined by ADA legislation; travel while on official business for the body,

state, or local agency; an immunocompromised child or other relative; physical or family medical emergency; military service obligation.

- Members who appear remotely for reasons other than just-cause or disability may participate as members of the public only.
- The minutes shall identify the specific provision that the member relied upon to participate remotely. The member is not required to disclose any specific medical condition or personal issue.

4. **SB823 Annual Plan Review (Discussion & Action)**

- The following changes will be made to the plan:
 - Page 28 – Blue Water Sailing numbers added.
 - Page 29 – Update education numbers. Pull education sections for activities and make its own section.
 - Page 52 – Add the OC Spray language.
 - Page 67 (Part 10) – Add the expenditures section.
